The Challenge of Ministry

Acts 6:1

"Now in those days when the number of disciples was multiplying, there arose a complaint against the Hebrews by the Hellenists, because their widows were neglected in the daily distribution."

Questions

- How large was the Christian community at this time?
- Was this food distribution problem real or imaginary?
- Was the neglect accidental or deliberate?

21st century application

Most of us do not have a great challenge with food distribution

> Acts 6:2-3

"Then the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said, "It is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and serve tables. Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business..."

- "But we will give our attention continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word."
- **PRAYER**
- MINISTRY OF THE WORD

The example of the apostles

The Ministry of the Word

Acts 6:4 "We will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word."

We have no right to preach and teach the Word of God to others unless we have first listened to the Word of God ourselves.

Acts 6:7

- "Then the word of God spread, and the number of disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were obedient to the faith."
- Word of God spread
- Number of disciples increased greatly
- Great many priests were obedient to the faith

Radical Leadership

 - Of good reputation
 - > Full of the Holy spirit
 - > Full of wisdom
- Devotion to prayer
- Devotion to the ministry of the Word
- > The process and the results will be supernatural.
