






### **Deuteronomy 6:4-7**




How can the church, including ministers and parents, teach our children to witness? We need to raise the bar of **Christianity in our** country, starting with our homes!

- Child starts sharing Jesus and gives neighbor a book or flier to read.






## 8. Gospel Tracts

- Give a mission offering.


