

Small groups and support groups

Small groups are an effective tool for healthy spiritual human relations.



- Small groups are the most effective way of bringing people into contact with Jesus and to help them become disciples. Small groups led by the Holy Spirit help the church to thrive.
- Our world longs for authentic, loving relationships in which God is involved.
- People who do not have an authentic relationship with God and other people will find other means of satisfying this longing: they look for acceptance and meaning for their lives in other ways.
- In our relationship with God and other people we find satisfaction and growth. The best way to reach other people is through authentic relationships.
- Small groups are an effective tool for spiritual growth and good relationships..

Biblical basis for small groups

- Group events in the New Testament
- ▶ The example of the early church: Acts 2:42–47



- Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favour of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."
- This is a description of the church at the time of the Apostles. They were concerned with all the things that are still important for a church today:
- ▶ Worship, companionship, spiritual growth (discipleship), church services and evangelism. The church was not active only for a few hours on one day each week they met during the week!

Why are small groups such an effective life-changing instrument?

- Church services: can be a very passive experience
- >Small groups: Relation to life is established through discussion and sharing.


